- **2023 Personalized Tax Organizer** (Questionnaire + Worksheets)
 - ✓ PLEASE ANSWER ALL THE QUESTIONS ON THE QUESTIONNAIRE Required of all clients
 - Returning Clients Worksheet attachments reflect your 2022 tax information for reference (Need Worksheets? Please call our office or go to www.islandcpas.com)
- Follow the Guidelines below to keep your Tax Preparation costs down:
 - ✓ Use your Organizer Worksheets for Data Entry
 - ✓ Please do not enter the same piece of data in two places
 - Enter TOTALS on Worksheets No receipts, please file receipts at home in case of audit
 - Write information clearly and darkly a BLUE or BLACK pen is BEST
 - NO POST-IT NOTES, PLEASE Please use white space for handwritten notes
 - NO HIGHLIGHTER, PLEASE It obscures the data when we scan your documents
 - ✓ If you deliver your data in electronic form, we do not need paper copies of those documents
- You will also need to provide the following Source Data:
- Forms W-2 for wages, salaries and tips.
- All Forms 1099 for interest, dividends, retirement, miscellaneous income, unemployment compensation, nonemployee compensation, Social Security, state or local refunds, gambling winnings, payment card or third-party network transactions, etc.
- Brokerage Statements showing investment transactions for stocks, bonds, digital assets, etc.
- Schedules K-1 showing income from partnerships, S corporations, estates and trusts.
- Statements supporting qualified educational expenses, deductions or distributions, including any Forms 1098-T, 1098-E, or 1099-Q.
- Statements from U.S. Department of Education supporting federal student loan forgiveness.
- All Forms 1095-A, 1095-B, 1095-C, 1099-H related to health care coverage or the Premium Tax Credit.
- All Forms 1099-SA and Forms 5498-SA for Health Savings Accounts.
- Statements supporting deductions for mortgage interest (Forms 1098) or taxes.
- Copies of Closing Statements regarding the sale or purchase of real property.

- **Legal Papers** for adoption, divorce, or separation involving custody of your dependent children.
- Six-digit Identity Protection PIN if sent to you by the IRS, for use filing your 2023 Tax Return.
- Any Tax Notices sent to you by the IRS or other taxing authority that we have not already received.
